Re: Millennium Challenge Compact – Monitoring and Evaluation


Dear Hon. Minister Kamara:

The purpose of this Implementation Letter is to set forth understandings regarding the execution of monitoring and evaluation activities under the Millennium Challenge Compact signed on October 2, 2015 (the “**Compact**”), between the United States of America, acting through the Millennium Challenge Corporation (“**MCC**”), and the Government of the Republic of Liberia, acting through the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning (the “**Government**”). Each capitalized term used but not defined in this letter has the meaning given to such term in the Compact.

MCC traditionally contracts the firms that independently evaluate MCC Compacts, while our country partners traditionally contract related data collection. However, after discussions between the Millennium Challenge Account-Liberia (“**MCA-Liberia**”) and MCC regarding strategies to ensure the quality of data collected in support of the Liberia Compact’s independent evaluations, MCA-Liberia and MCC have agreed that MCC will manage evaluation-related data collection in addition to contracting an evaluation firm. As a result, the Government will make available to MCC \$2,000,000 of MCC Funding previously designated for data collection related to the independent evaluation of the Energy Project, to be drawn from the Monitoring and Evaluation budget as set forth in Exhibit A to Annex II of the Compact. This arrangement can be expected to improve the quality of evaluation data collected and yield efficiencies in the management of the overall evaluation. As the Roads Project develops, MCC and MCA-Liberia will discuss whether this Project would also benefit from this arrangement.
