Re: Expiration of the 609(g) Grant and Implementation Agreement

Dear Honorable Minister Tweah:

This letter refers to the Grant and Implementation Agreement signed on February 25, 2015 (as amended, the “*Grant Agreement*”), between the Millennium Challenge Corporation (“*MCC*”) and the Government of the Republic of Liberia (the “*Government*”), through which MCC granted the Government up to \$2,800,000 United States Dollars in order to facilitate the development and implementation of the compact. Each capitalized term used but not defined in this letter has the meaning given to such term in the Grant Agreement.


Under Section 6.1(a) of the Grant Agreement, the agreement terminates on the date on which all of the Activities (as defined in the Grant Agreement) have been fully performed and final payment has been made with respect to such performance. As of the date of this letter, all such Activities have been completed and all final payments have been made. Accordingly, the term of the Grant Agreement has now expired and the Grant Agreement is hereby terminated. MCC requests that the Government and MCA-Liberia complete any further administrative actions required in connection with the expiration of the Grant Agreement.
