The following are the requests for clarification from the Consultants:

1.	Is there a limit on the rate of the consultant?	<i>Kindly refer to clause 3, a), b) and c) of the LOI.</i>
2.	Given the end date of the compact of 01/2021 and the time the conception and implementation of the RIMS may take, is there provision to conduct the project beyond 01/21?	<p>An indicative timeline for the design, development and implementation of RIMS has been provided in Section 8.0 (Table 1).</p> <p>In addition it is clearly stated in Section 9.1 of the LOI that, <i>"The overall duration of this assignment shall not exceed three hundred and sixty - six calendar days equivalent to fifty - two (52) weeks as detailed in Table 1 of Section 8.0 and shall not exceed January 19, 2021 - which is the Compact End Date (CED)"</i>.</p> <p>Essentially, the implementation of the RIMS project cannot extend beyond January 19, 2021.</p>
