1. Millennium Challenge Account Liberia (MCA-Liberia), has concluded evaluation of applications for the “*MCA-Liberia Compact Close-Out Consultant*”, and intends to award a contract to:

**2. Summary and Scope of the Requirement:**

MCA-Liberia requires the assistance of an Individual Consultant to draft and develop a Program Closure Plan (PCP) for MCA-Liberia. The PCP is an important document that shall include a description of the administrative, financial, and legal steps necessary to be implemented by MCA-Liberia, LEC (as an additional Accountable Entity designated by the Government and as an Implementing Entity), all other Implementing Entities, contractors, and parties involved in Program Implementation, in accordance with the proposed deadlines and the Program Closure Guidelines (PCG). The PCP should cover all Projects included in the Program, including those for which LEC is an Accountable Entity. The PCP must contain actions and activities to be carried out (i) prior to the Compact End Date, and (ii) during the Compact Closure Period (January 20, 2021 – May 19, 2021). In developing the PCP, the Consultant and MCA-Liberia aim to (i) increase knowledge and strengthen the capacity of MCA-Liberia and LEC staff in preparing for the Program closure and the implementation of

the closure, and (ii) submit the final draft of the PCP to MCC no later than January 20, 2020.
